


A for Ant

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A nu loved apples. She was eating an apple near the anthill in the garden. The ants were going to attend an assembly in school.

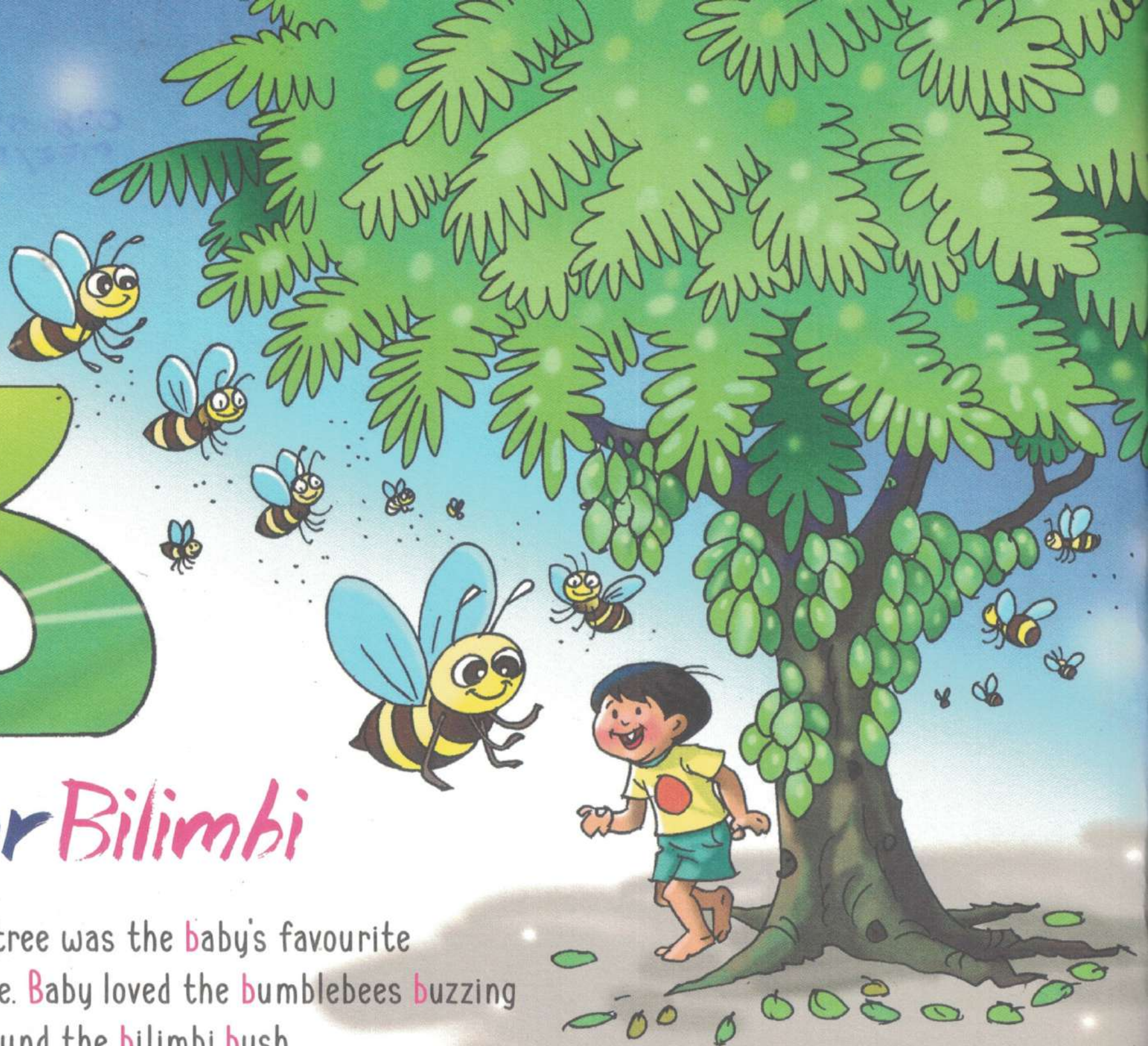


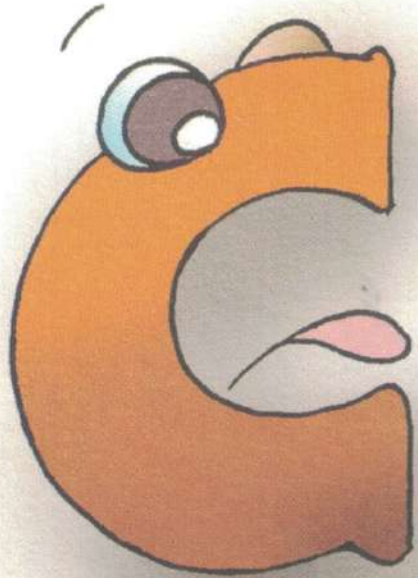

B for Bilimbi

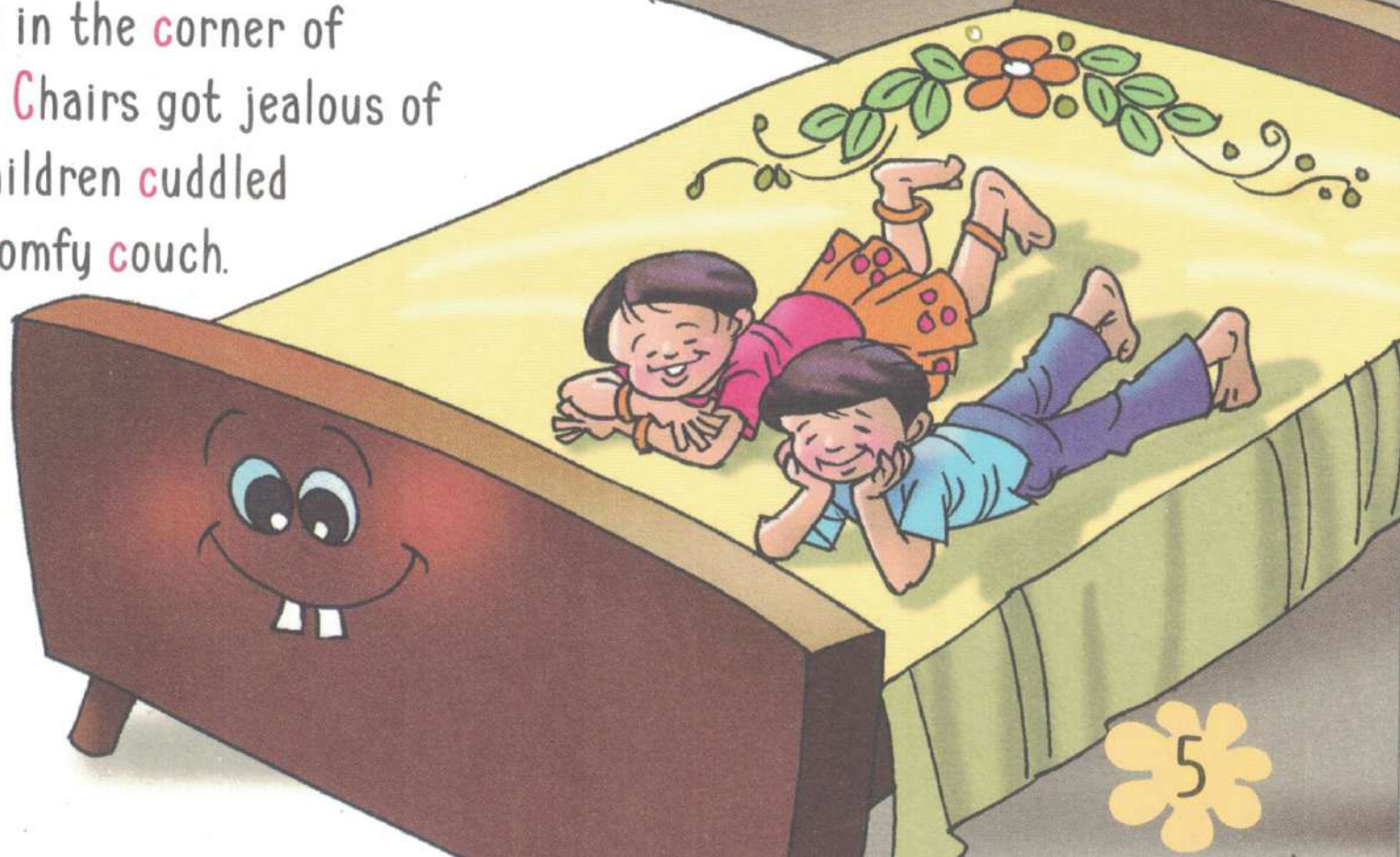
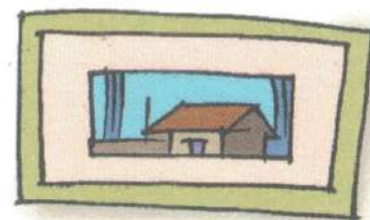
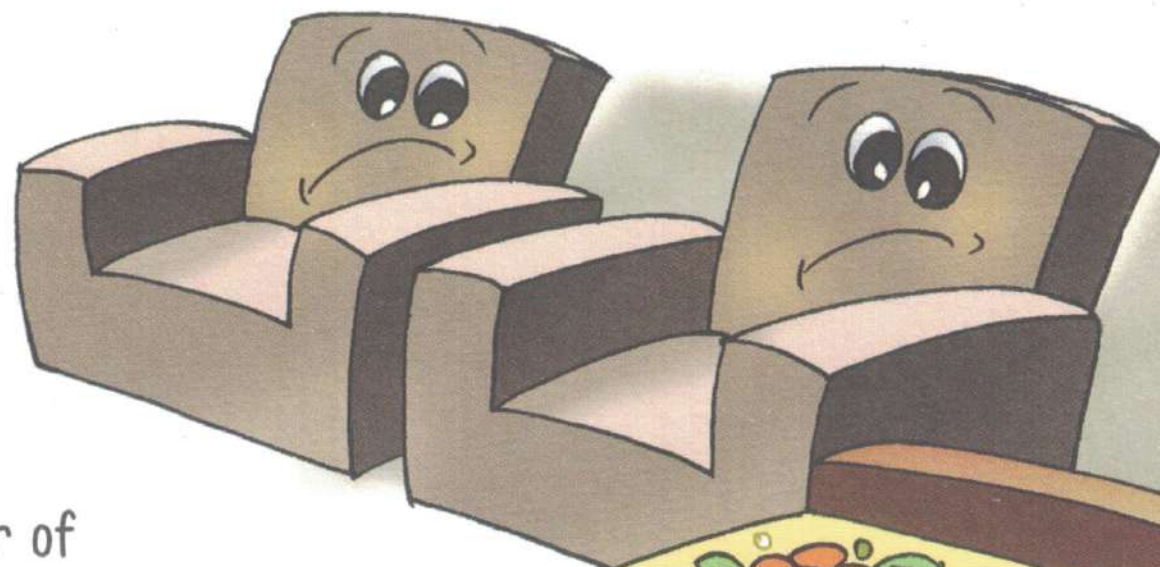
Bilimbi tree was the baby's favourite tree. Baby loved the bumblebees buzzing around the bilimbi bush.

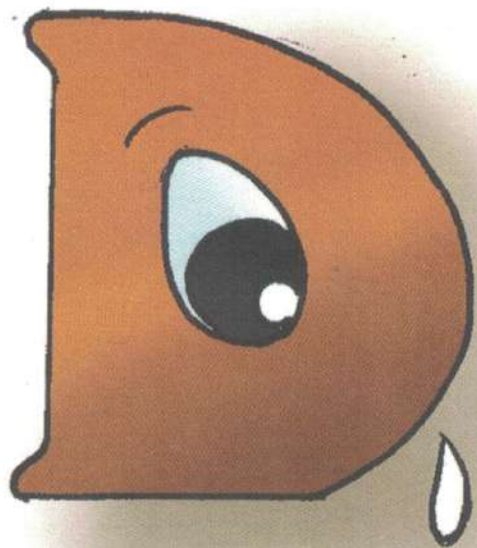




C for Couch

D for Dessert

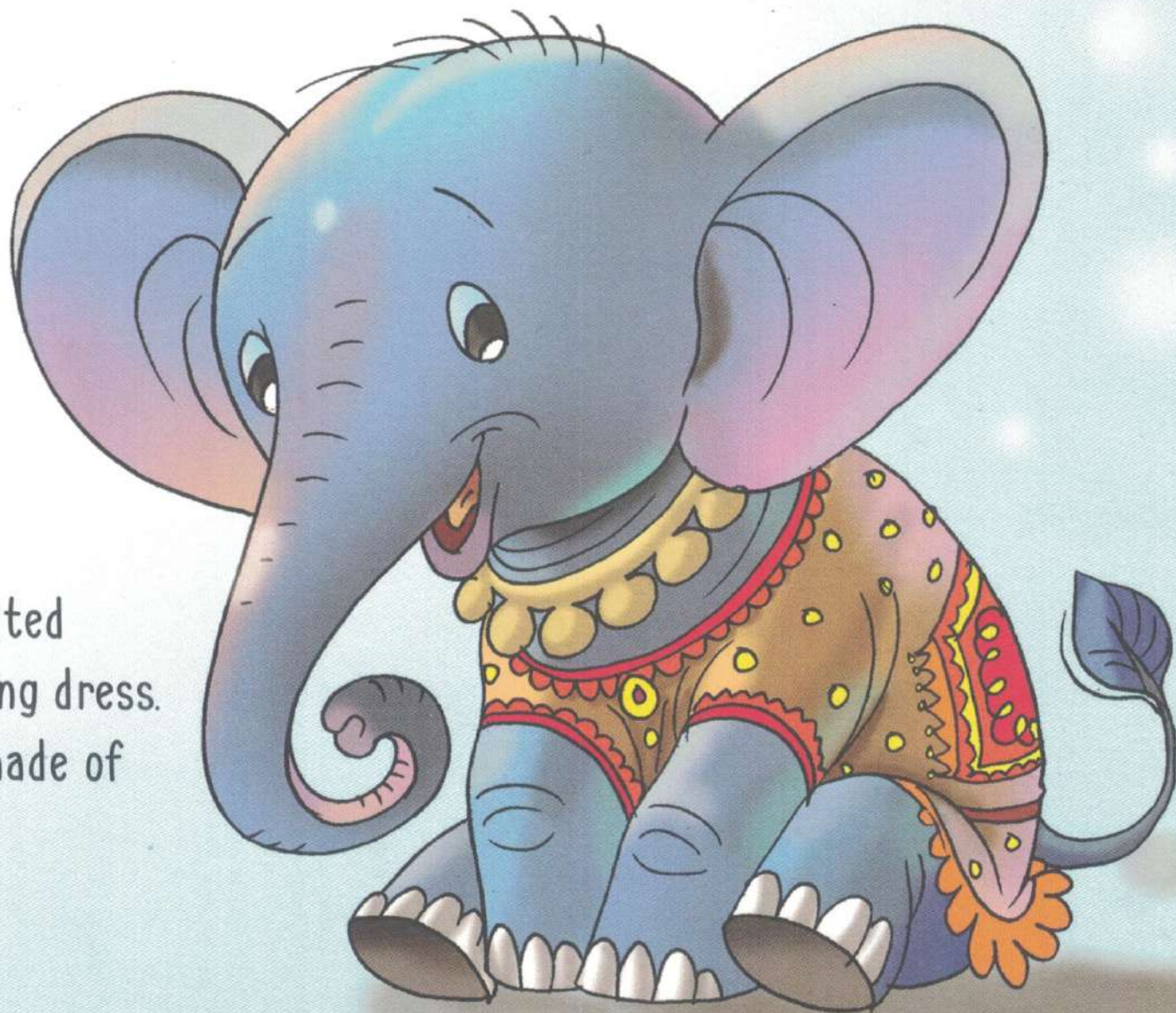
Dada loved desserts made at home. Doughnut dipped in chocolate was his dearest dessert.





E for Elephant

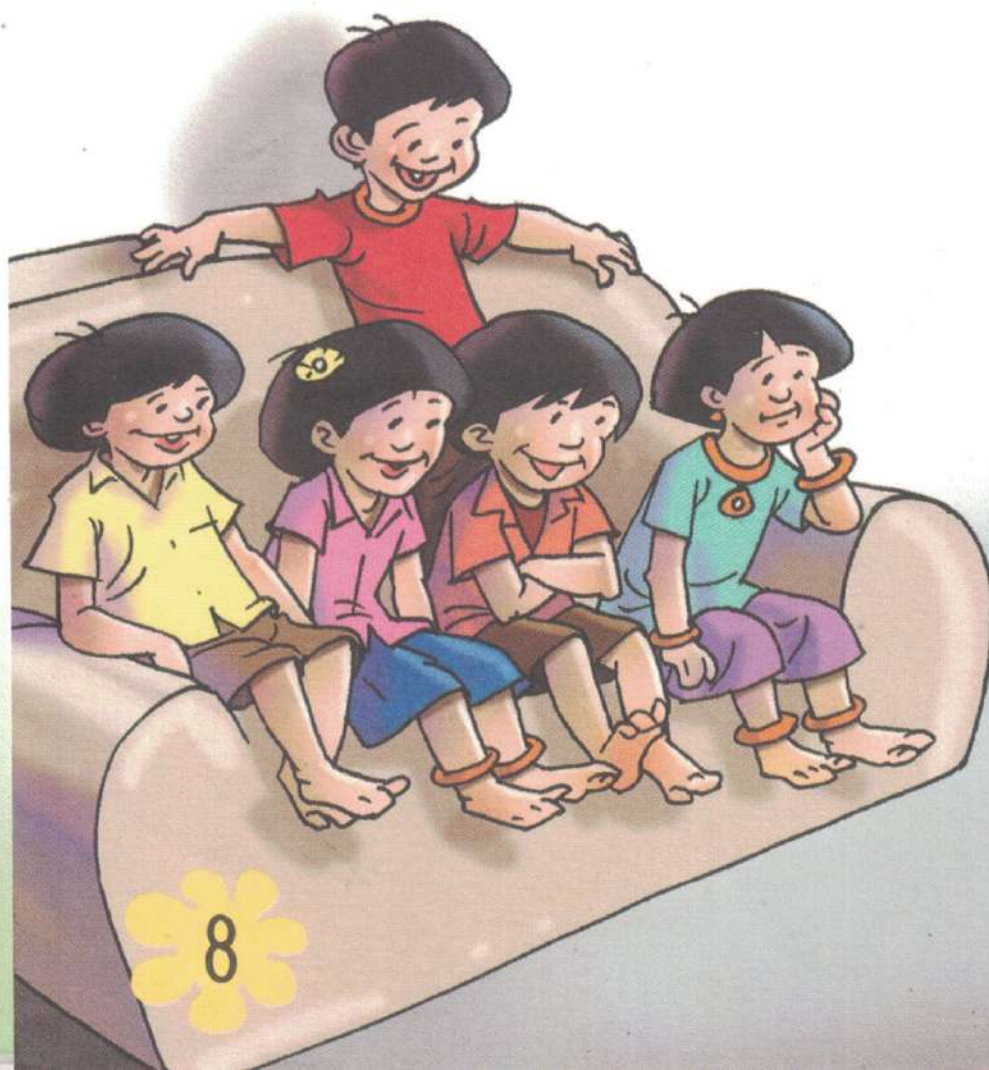
Ela the elephant was excited about her new evening dress. She got a necklace made of egg shells too.

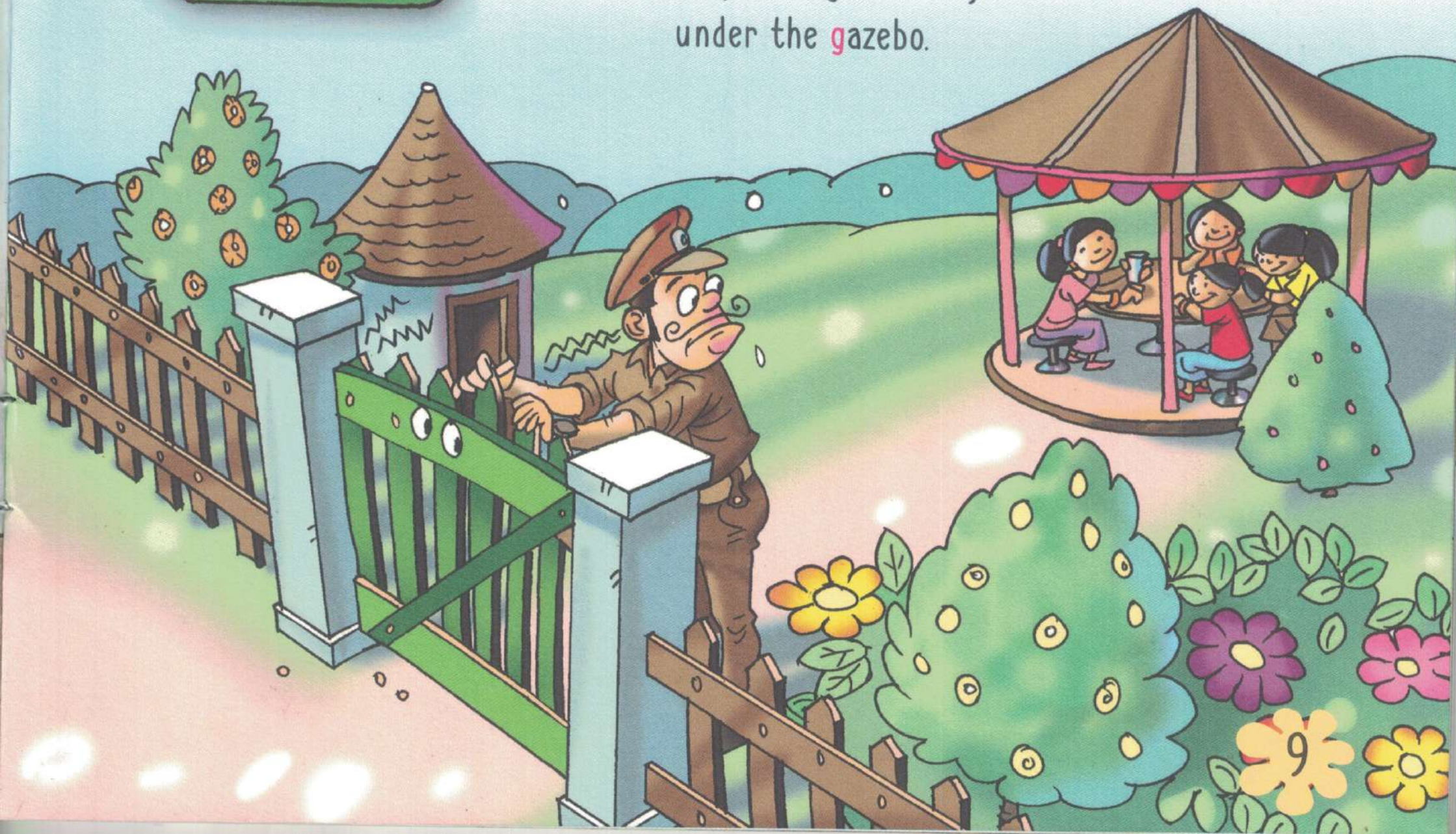
Kids love having fun with their friends. Five friends sat together to watch their favourite cartoon film on TV.

The green gate in the garden creaked when opened. The girls giggled their way through as they sat under the gazebo.

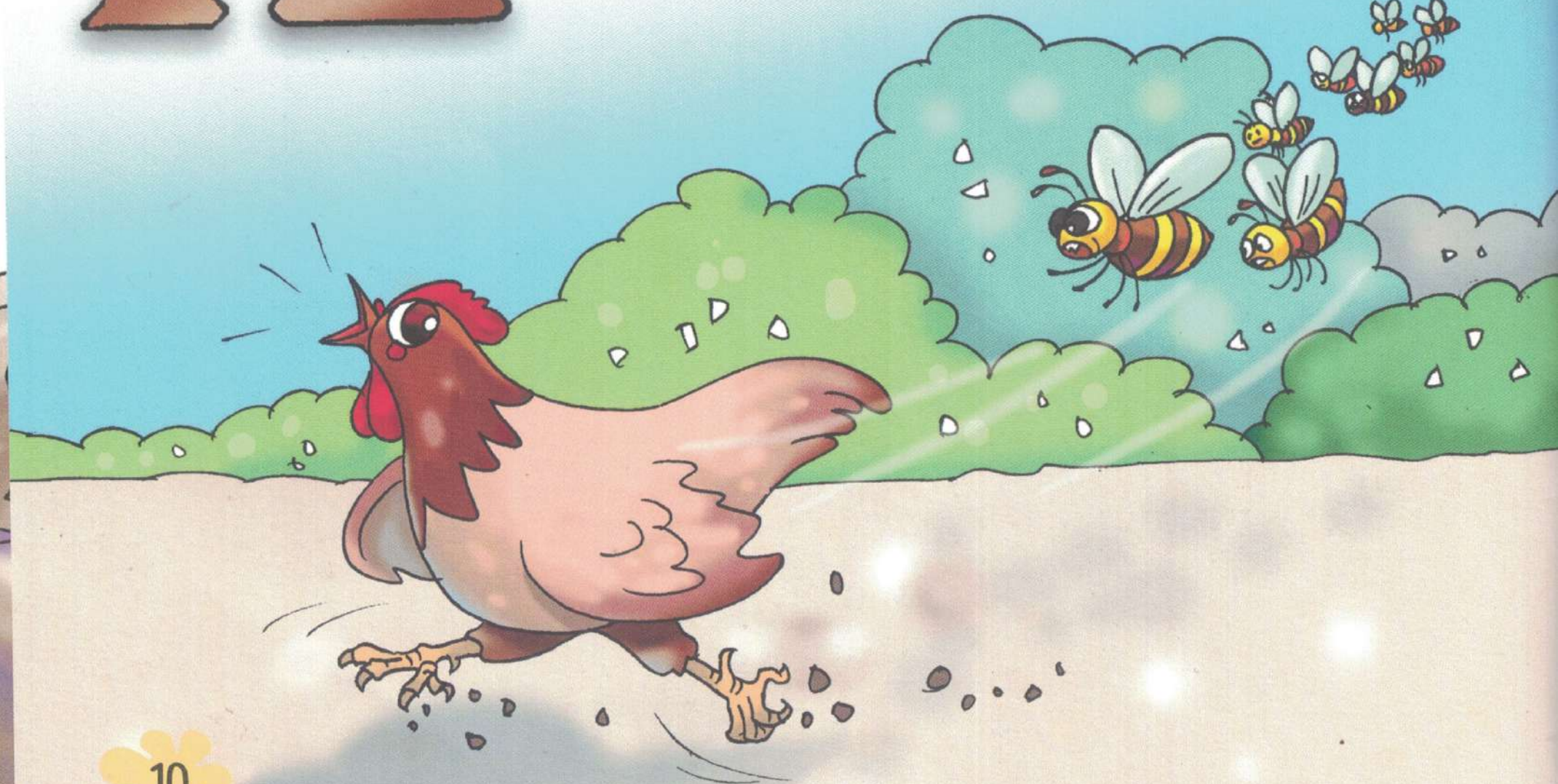

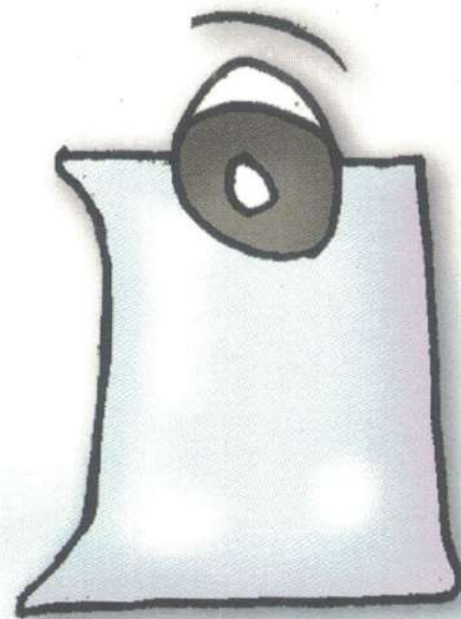
Honey was the house's pet hen.

with her infant brother.



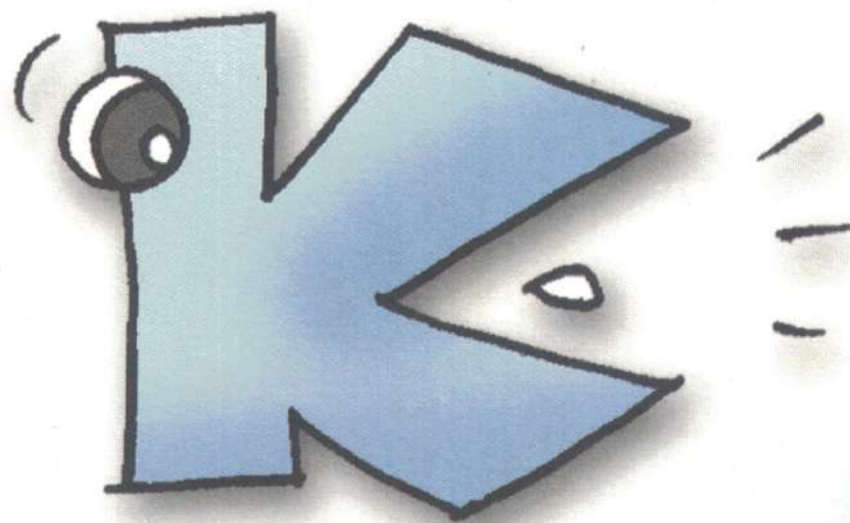

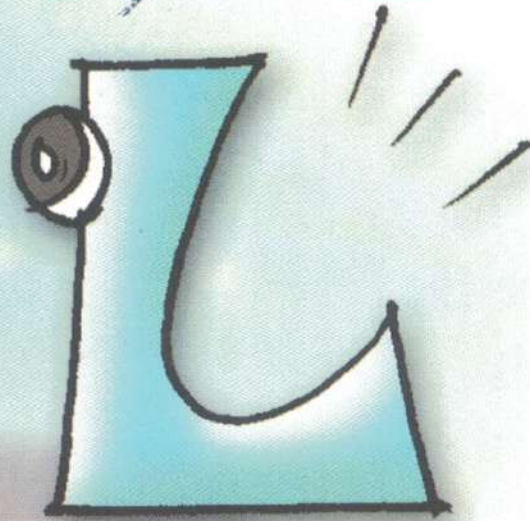
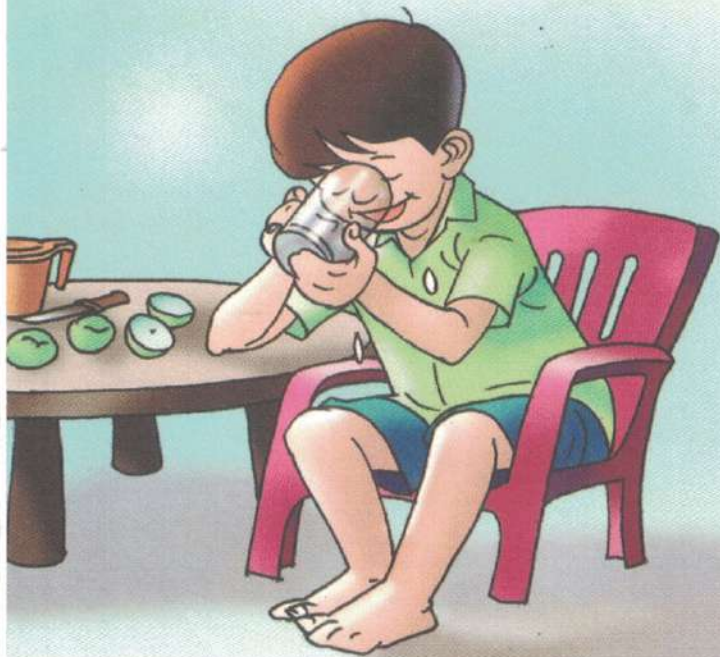


K for Kitten

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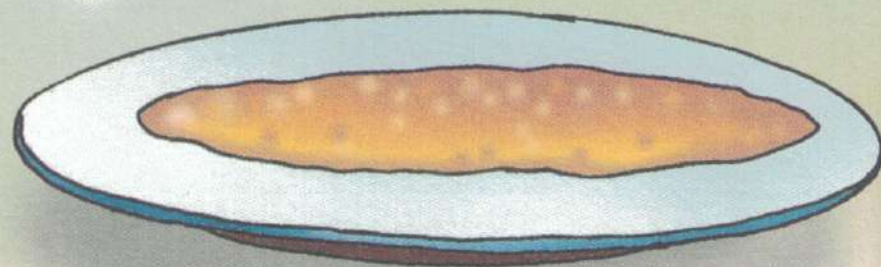
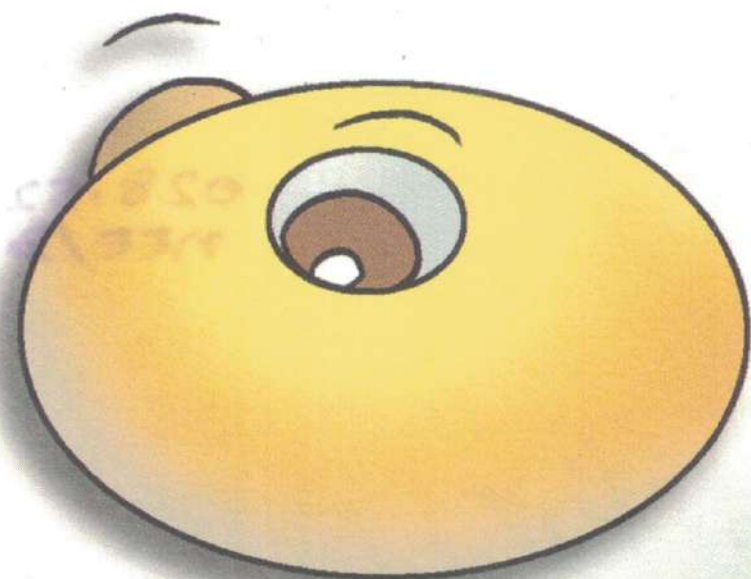
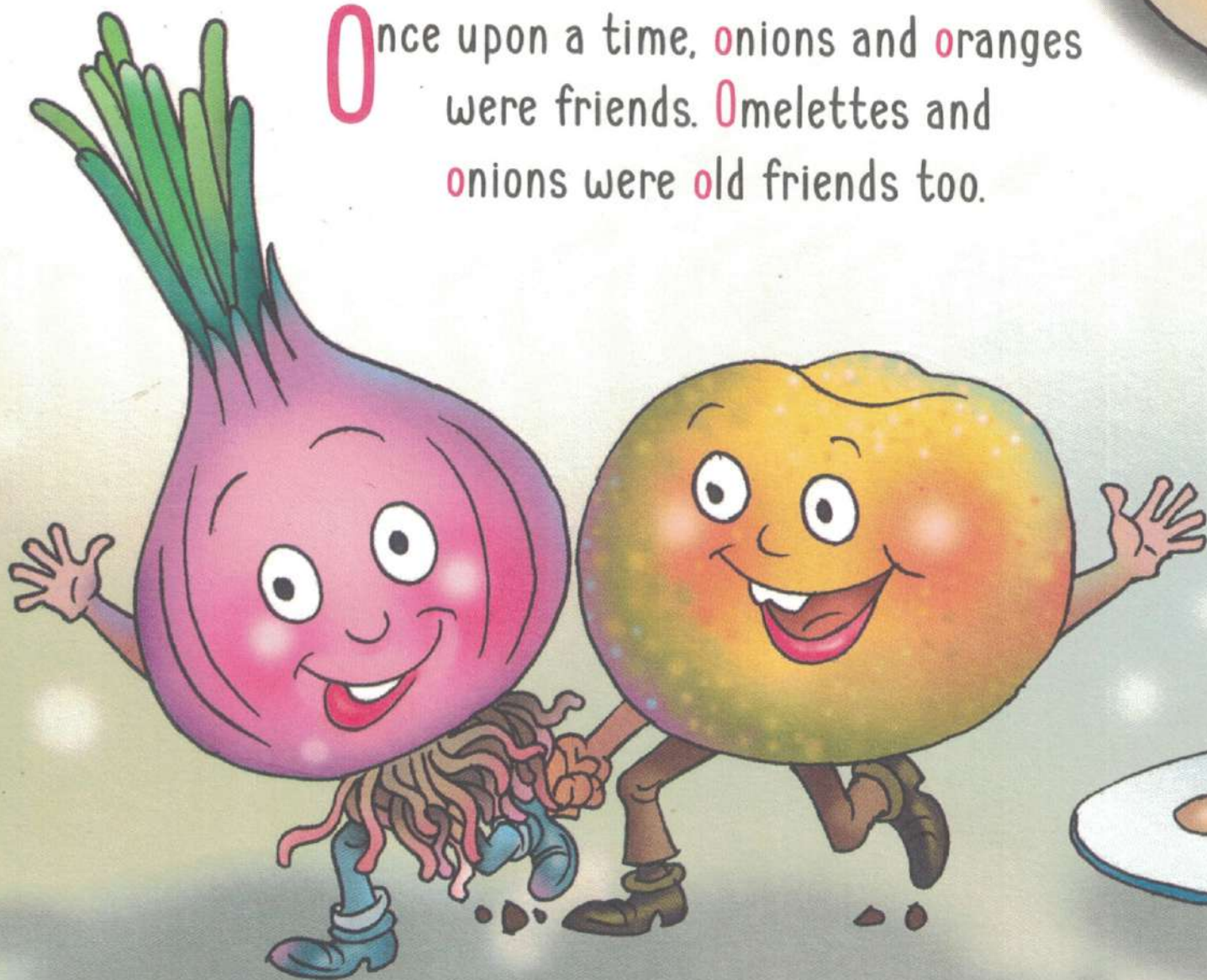
N for Name

Once upon a time, onions and oranges were friends. Omelettes and onions were old friends too.

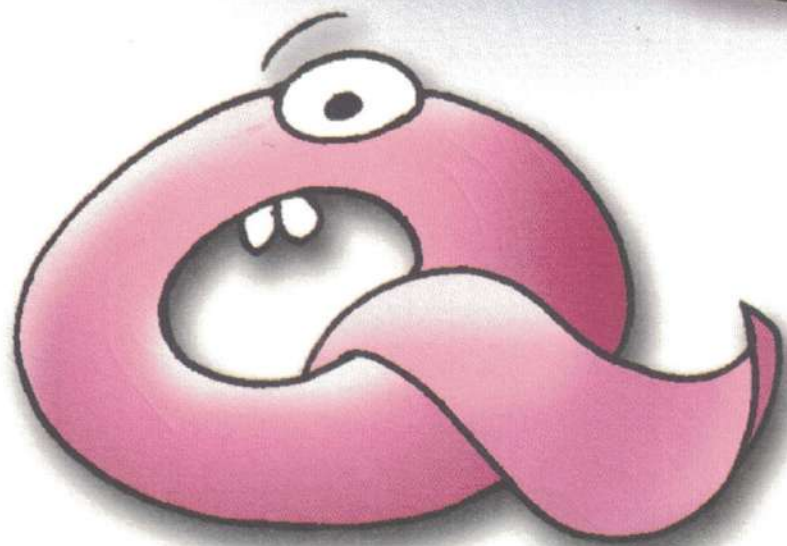

U for Uncle

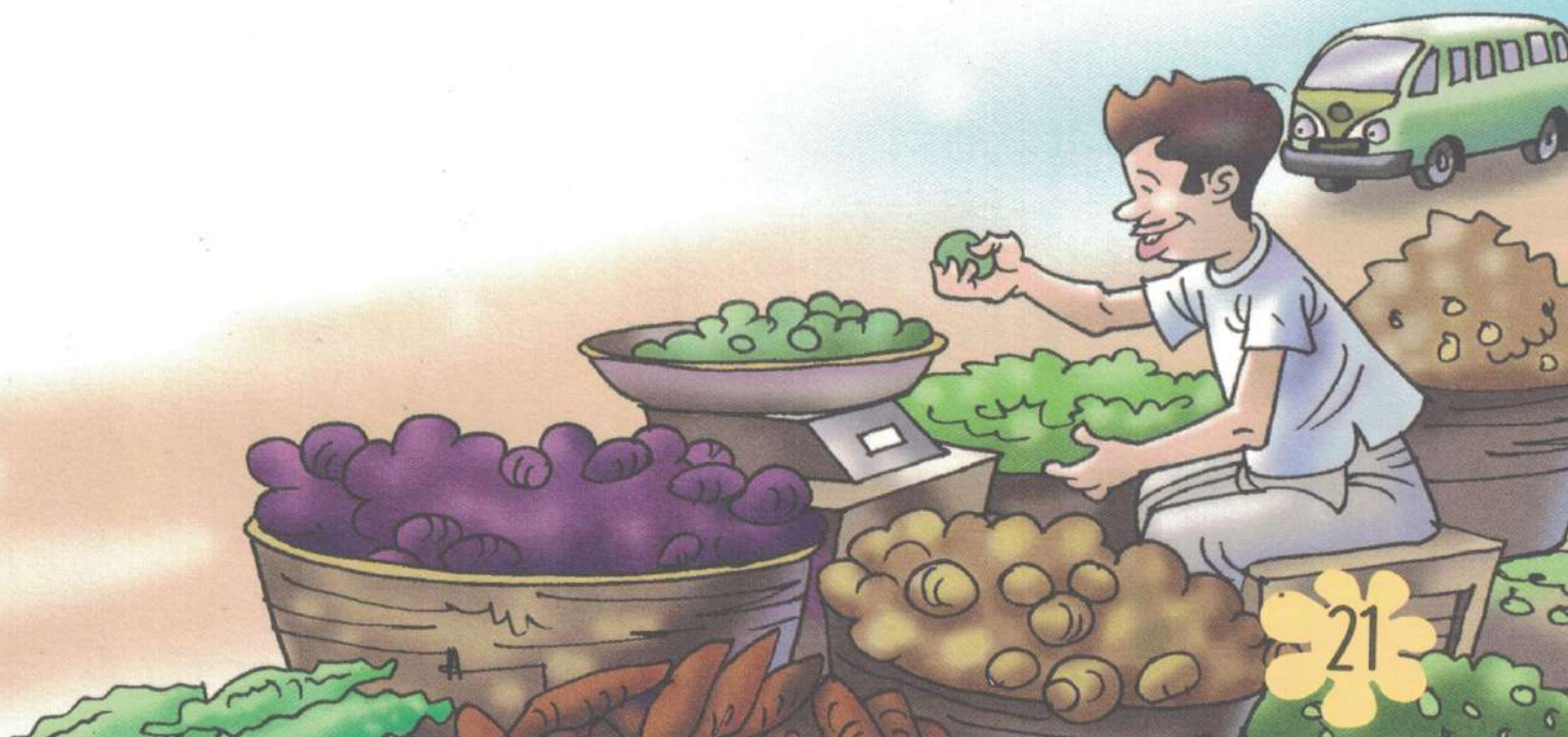
Uncle Unni used to wear a uniform in the USA.
